The Alburnett City Council met in regular session on **Thursday May 9, 2013** at the Alburnett City Hall. Mayor Boesenberg called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with council members Wood, Lawrence, Trumm and Schantz present. Titler arrived at 7:02 PM. Other present were Joe Horaney, Curt Walter, Deb Bell, Deputy Steffens and Steve Graham.

Motion to approve the agenda was moved by Wood, second by Schantz. Motion carried.

The mayor apologized to the council for his actions at the April council meeting.

Fire Department Report – Steve Graham reported there were four calls for service last month; two medical calls in the City, one medical call in the township and one mutual aid. The Fire Department, Mayor and Council will begin collecting data for the CDBG grant income survey on June 1.

Deb Bell, Alburnett Community Diamond Club, informed the council of plans for Benefit Day to be held on August 3, 2013.

Joe Horaney, CR/LC Solid Waste Agency, spoke about services available to Linn County residents. The Solid Waste Agency at 1954 County Home Road accepts appliances, bikes, tires and scrap metal; it also offers drive thru recycling. Starting in July 2012 carpet recycling became available. The new Rescurce Recovery building should be open late September or October.

Curt Walter, Verizon Wireless, approached the council about acquiring an access/utility easement through city-owned property to a proposed telecommunications facility located on Esther Graham property. Verizon wireless plans to build a 180 foot tall monopole, along with a 12' x 30' control shelter and necessary fencing. Motion to grant a 20 foot wide easement on city-owned property to Verizon Wireless was moved by Wood, second by Titler. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the consent agenda with additional invoices from Visa for \$735.43, Kirkwood Community College for \$84.96 and Roto-Rooter for \$380.00, was moved by Lawrence, second by Wood. Motion carried.

Motion to donate \$100.00 to the Alburnett FFA for their help with clean up day, was moved by Wood, second by Trumm. Motion carried.

Motion to accept Wellmark BC/BS Health Insurance renewal, was moved by Schantz, second by Titler. Motion carried.

Sheriff's Report – Deputy Steffens reported there were 60.26 hours of service provided last month versus 43.0 contracted.

A job description for part-time public works help will be presented for approval at the June council meeting.

Lawrence and Titler volunteered to supervise the day-to-day activities of the city clerk.

The Budget Amendment Public Hearing will be on May 23, 2013 at 7:00 PM at Alburnett City Hall.
