The Alburnett City Council met in special session September 10, 2009, at 7:05 P.M. at the Alburnett Fire Station Office. Mayor Boesenberg called the meeting to order with council members Trumm, Schantz, Titler, Wood and Robertson present.

Wood moved: Schantz seconded to amend the agenda from a closed session to a regular meeting. 5-0.

Wood moved: Schantz seconded to approve the agenda. 5-0.

Council member Wood handed out a wage/benefit sheet that he put together for council review. There was discussion of reviews and compensation. Schantz moved: Trumm seconded to approve a wage increase of .11 cents per hour and \$40.00 more per month towards health care for both city employees.

A Roll Call vote was taken with council members Wood, Titler, Schantz and Trumm voting "AYES" and Robertson voting "NAY"

Dave Haugen with MSA Professionals – went over the I & I and waste water reports and highlighted items that were complete. There was discussion of things that could be done to help with the issue of water back up when there is excessive rain. Wood moved: Trumm seconded to televise the pipes on Moothart and Howard Street from Main Avenue to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Main Avenue from Laurie to Roosevelt Street. 5-0. A Roll Call vote was taken with council members Wood, Titler, Schantz, Robertson and Trumm voting "AYES" 5-0. It was decided to revisit this issue once the pipes were all televised, and the council can make a more informed decision of how best to address possible options to fix the problem.

City Maintenance – Steve Graham – Received two certifications from the DNR. Graham had a meeting with the DNR and they went over operations. Over all DNR said Graham was doing a fine job.

Wood moved; Trumm seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:55 p.m. 5-0.
