City Council meetings are held the first Thursday of each month. The meetings are held at the Alburnett Fire Station Office at 7:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. The minutes of the City Council meetings are published in the Linn-Newsletter within two weeks following the meeting. City Hall is open Monday – Friday 8:30 to 4:30. Closed 12:00– 1:00 for lunch.



Water/Sewer billing - The water/sewer meters are read around the last few days of the month. All bills are due by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month by close of business. On the 21<sup>st</sup> a penalty is assessed and delinquent notices will be mailed. Overdue bills are due within 10 days of the 21<sup>st</sup>. Any bills not paid by then are subject to shutoff. July 1 there will be a base rate water increase of \$4.00 and a base rate sewer increase of \$1.00.



City Compost Site – The City compost site is for grass, leaves and brush **only**. The site is being abused. If it continues to be abused it may be **discontinued** all

together. Please be sure you are not putting any paper, plastic, cement, railroad ties, metal, etc. in the compost. A few are ruining it for many. Residents can take any and all yard waste to CR/LC Solid Waste Agency on County Home Road.

Grass Clippings in the Street – As you mow your lawn please be sure **not** to mow the grass into the street. If you do get grass on the streets you need to sweep it up and dispose of it. Grass left in the street can plug up the storm sewer and is costly to clean out.

Water Project Update : The new well is complete and the well house is being constructed. The well is 400' deep and can pump approx 190 gallons per minute. The water main project should begin June 14<sup>th</sup> with a final completion date of mid October.

Building Permits : With the adoption of the International Building Code 2006 Edition the only 2 items **exempt** from a permit are fences less than 3' high and one-story detached structures with floor area not to exceed 120 square feet.
